We encourage families and students to follow the latest CDC suggestions. If you don't feel well, stay home. If you believe you have symptoms and know you have been exposed, please get tested.

Masking is optional under normal circumstances. If you feel strongly your child should always wear a mask, please let the school know so we can support you in your efforts with your kids. If you are *not* vaccinated, and have household exposure, family members must stay home for the required days as applicable to your situation. If you have been vaccinated, but have household exposure, the health department requires masking but you may continue to attend school and activities.

At-home COVID tests are available to our families. If you have been exposed, and are experiencing symptoms, please contact the nurse to receive a free at home test kit.

Symptoms of COVID-19: New onset of dry cough, new onset of shortness of breath, or loss of senses of taste and smell. One of these might indicate COVID-19.

Other symptoms to watch: a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher, chills, muscle aches, headache, sore throat, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue. Two or more of these might indicate COVID-19.

\*Quarantined persons do NOT have COVID, but have been exposed in a highly saturated environment.
